### J. Martens (Asia-Pacific) Pte Ltd successfully completes Module load-out for Petrobras Mexilhão Project



J. Martens (Asia-Pacific) Pte Ltd, in co-operation with Enterprise Logistics of Brazil, recently successfully completed the load out of a Mono Ethylene Glycol (MEG) module for Petrobras' Mexilhão project.

The Module weighed 558 ton, measuring 19.25 x 12.00 x 17.50 in meters.

The Mexilhão 1 platform, which will be installed in a water depth of 172m, will be the largest offshore metallic structure ever erected in Brazilian waters. The platform will stand 230m tall.
